MATTERS ARISING

It was reported that the questionnaire was now ready and was presented to, and approved by, the meeting. Deputy Clerk to print off first 700 asap.

Cllrs Bedford and Allsopp had had a very successful meeting with the Hatfield Miners Group and DMBC Cllr Nigel Ball (cabinet member for communities). Cllr Ball was interested in the group's thoughts on the pit site.

It was reported that at this moment in time the proposed visit to the pit head was not able to go ahead. Cllrs Bedford and Allsopp were having a meeting with Cllr Ball on 2/3/18 and hopefully there will be some positive news after that.

FUNDING

Cllr Bedford confirmed that he had managed to procure an initial grant of £2500. This had to be spent by the end of March at which time further grants would be sought.

Cllr Bedford presented a proposed breakdown of how the money could be spent. This would be put before the Town Council at the next Council meeting.

A quote for some of the work had been received from S4All which was approved by the 2 members of the group who were eligible to vote.
